This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process.  Applicable Compliance Method:
 Compliance with the above visible PE limitation shall be determined by the method specified in OAC Rule 3745-17-03(B)(1).
 Emissions Limitation:
 0.551 lb of PE/hr

 Applicable Compliance Method:
 If required, the permittee shall demonstrate compliance through testing in accordance with the method specified in OAC Rule 3745-17-03(B)(10).

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. If probable cause exists indicating this emissions unit is causing or contributing to a nuisance in violation of OAC Rule 3745-15-07, the permittee shall be required to submit and implement a control program that will bring this emissions unit into compliance.
