Enclosed please find a modification to the Ohio EPA Permit to Install referenced above which will modify the terms and conditions.



The Permit to Install issued to Ohio Valley Coal Co. (PTI No. 17-845) is hereby modified in the following manner:


Terms and Conditions on Page 4 and 6 and Description on Permit Page of Permit to Install issued January 24, 1991.



The following sources are subject to the applicable provisions of the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) as promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, 40 CFR Part 60.

The application and enforcement of these standards are delegated to the Ohio EPA. The requirements of 40 CFR Part 60 are also federally enforceable.

1. Construction date (no later than 30 days after such date);
2. Anticipated start-up date (not more than 60 days or less than 30 days prior to such date);
3. Actual start-up date (within 15 days after such date); and
4. Date of performance testing (at least 30 days prior to testing).

ADDITIONAL SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Source identification and applicable rules:

The operations covered by this Permit to Operate and the applicable particulate air pollution control regulations are:

Load Out - OAC Rule 3745-17-08(B), NSPS, Subpart Y, OAC Rule 3745-31-05.

Allowable particulate and fugitive dust emission limitations:

Ohio Valley Coal Co. shall comply with the applicable requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code and the applicable provisions herein as they relate to the fugitive dust emission source identified in paragraph A upon the effective date of the Permit to Operate.

Truck Load Out

In accordance with the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-31-05, 17-08(B) and NSPS Subpart Y, Ohio Valley Coal Co. shall maintain sufficient moisture content and decrease the drop height of the front end loader and conveyORIZED loading stations 1 & 2 for the purpose of minimizing and eliminating fugitive dust, such that no gases shall be discharged to the atmosphere which exhibit 20% opacity or greater.
