Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) This emissions unit, and its associated fabric filter control system, shall be maintained regularly in accordance with good engineering practices and the recommendations of the respective manufacturers in order to minimize air contaminant emissions.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The pressure drop across the baghouse shall be maintained within the range of 2.0 - 7.0 inches of water while the emissions unit is in operation.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall properly install, operate, and maintain equipment to monitor the pressure drop across the baghouse while the emissions unit is in operation. The monitoring equipment shall be installed, calibrated, operated, and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, instructions, and operating manual(s). The permittee shall record the pressure drop across the baghouse on a weekly basis.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit pressure drop deviation (excursion) reports that identify all periods of time during which the pressure drop across the baghouse did not comply with the allowable range specified above.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
 - a. Emissions Limitation: PM: 0.01 grain of particulate matter emissions per dry standard cubic foot of exhaust gases.

Applicable Compliance Method: Method 5 of 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A.
 - b. Emissions Limitation: VE: 0% opacity.

Applicable Compliance Method: Method 9 of 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A.

2. Additional Terms and Conditions		
(a) In accordance with PTI No.: 02-2040, issued July 17, 1985, the solvent system of the coatings employed in this emissions unit shall be non-photochemically reactive in accordance with the definition in OAC 3745-21-01(C)(5). The coatings shall not come into contact with flame, be baked, be heat cured, or be heat polymerized in the presence of oxygen.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain documentation on whether or not each coating and/or cleanup material is a photochemically reactive material.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall report any use of non-photochemically reactive material(s). These reports shall be submitted to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.
