This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. Applicant is prohibited from using oxygen lances or powder metal cutting.
2. Applicant shall continue to employ other metal cutting/breaking methods such as hydraulic shear and a drop ball to minimize visible particulate emissions.
3. Fire extinguishers shall be located near any cutting station(s) and shall be employed promptly to put out any accidental fires.
4. Applicant shall employ good cutting practices when cutting torches are used in order to minimize visible particulate emissions. Such practices shall include, but not be limited to, the following items: cutting metal clean of oil or other combustible fluids, minimizing flame impingement onto the ground, and use of appropriately sized cutting torch(es).
5. In accordance with OAC 3745-19-03, the open burning of solid waste at this facility is prohibited. Any accidental fires that may be caused by metal scrap salvaging operations shall also be reported.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain a daily log on the metal cutting operations at the pit scrap cutting area and at the roll scrap cutting area. This log shall record the date and the number of torches in operation.

D. Reporting Requirements

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

Emission Limitation: Visible Particulate Emission shall not exceed twenty percent opacity as a three minute average.

Applicable Compliance Method: Method 9 of 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A.
