This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.

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II. **Operational Restrictions**

1. Pursuant to PTI Application No. 02-8711, which was effective on October 19, 1994, and was not public noticed, the maximum coating usage for this unit shall not exceed 10 gallons per day.

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III. **Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information on a daily basis:
 - a. The name and identification of each coating, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating in pounds per gallon, as applied.
 - c. The number of gallons of each coating applied.
 - d. The name and identification of each cleanup material employed.
 - e. The VOC content of each cleanup material, in pounds per gallon.
 - f. The number of gallons of each cleanup material employed.
 - g. The total VOC emissions from all coatings and cleanup materials employed, in pounds.
 - h. The total volume, in gallons, of all of the coatings employed.

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IV. **Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any daily record showing the emission of more than 62 lbs VOC/day. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 30 days following the end of the

calendar month.

2. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any daily record showing that the coating line employs more than 10 gallons per day. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.
3. The permittee shall also submit annual reports which specify the total VOC emissions from this emissions unit for the previous calendar year. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.

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V. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section B.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

62 lbs VOC/day

 - c. The daily volume-weighted average VOC content of all coatings of each specific type (i.e., extreme performance, zinc rich primer, or other coatings), as applied, calculated in accordance with the equation specified in paragraph (B)(9) of OAC rule 3745-21-10 for Cvoc,2.
2. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line for the coating of large appliances:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied.

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IV. **Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any daily record showing that the daily volume-weighted average VOC content exceeds the applicable limitation of miscellaneous metal parts coating. The notification shall include a description of the type of coating (i.e., extreme performance, zinc rich primer, or other coatings) and a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.
2. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any monthly record showing the use of noncomplying coatings. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.

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V. **Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
 - a. Emission Limitation:
 - 3.5 lbs VOC/gallon coating, excluding water and exempt solvents, for extreme performance coating;
 - 4.0 lbs VOC/gallon coating, excluding water and exempt solvents, for zinc rich primer;
 - 3.0 lbs VOC/gallon coating, excluding water and exempt solvents, for all other miscellaneous metal coatings.

OAC rule 3745-21-10(B). Formulation data or USEPA Method 24 (for coatings) shall be used to determine the volatile organic compound contents of the coatings. Compliance shall be based upon record keeping specified in Section A. III. 1. of this permit.

2. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line for the coating of large appliances:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied.

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IV. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any daily record showing that the daily volume-weighted average VOC content exceeds the applicable limitation of miscellaneous metal parts coating. The notification shall include a description of the type of coating (i.e., extreme performance, zinc rich primer, or other coatings) and a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.
2. The permittee shall notify the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) in writing of any monthly record showing the use of noncomplying coatings. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office) within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.

 - 3.0 lbs VOC/gallon coating, excluding water and exempt solvents, for all other miscellaneous metal coatings.
