This report shall be submitted to the Northeast District Office within 15 days following the end of the calendar month.
2. The permittee shall submit an annual report which summarizes the data recorded in Section A.III. and indicates the total annual emissions from all organic materials used in this emissions unit. This report shall be submitted to the Ohio EPA Northeast District Office by January 31 of each year for the operations of the previous calendar year.
