The Permit to Install issued to L and F Products (PTI No. 15-1059) is hereby modified in the following manner:


Terms and Conditions on page 4 of Permit to Install issued on August 18, 1993.

Unless otherwise indicated, BAT for any miscellaneous storage tanks identified within this permit consists of the use of submerged fill into the storage tanks. The submerged fill pipe(s) are to be installed within six (6) inches of the bottom of the storage tank.

CONSTRUCTION COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION

The applicant shall provide Ohio EPA with a written certification (see enclosed form) that the facility has constructed in accordance with the Permit to Install application and the terms and conditions of the Permit to Install. The certification shall be provided to Ohio EPA upon completion of construction but prior to startup of the source.
