However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 1. In accordance with the provisions of OAC rule 3745-17-05, the permittee is required to maintain the fugitive dust control measures/equipment currently being employed.

 - a. Coal spills on the roadways and parking areas shall be promptly cleaned up.
 - b. The permittee shall post speed limit signs on the roadways within the facility, excluding the main access road. The speed limit shall not exceed 10 miles per hour.
 - c. The permittee shall take reasonable precautions to ensure that trucks leaving the facility will not have pockets of coal or residual amounts of coal on platforms, ledges, etc., of trucks which might be deposited on public roadways.
 - d. The permittee shall ensure that all open-bodied coal trucks or trailers using the public streets are covered when loaded and in motion on the facility. This condition does not apply to open-bodied vehicles that do not normally leave the facility, or that are empty and being loaded.

The permittee shall use one of the following control measures on an "as needed" basis:

- a. water spray system as delivered by either water cannon system or truck mounted sprays (except when impractical because of the possibility of freezing); or
- b. the application of a surface crusting agent (e.g., Chemsolv or equivalent).

Additionally, the permittee shall implement the following precautionary operating practices: maintenance of as low a pile height as feasible and compaction of piles consistent with operating requirements.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain records which include the following information for the material storage piles located at this facility:
 - a. the date dust suppressants (Chemsolv or equivalent) were applied to material storage pile surfaces;
 - b. the portions of the material storage piles which were treated with the dust suppressants; and
 - c. the application rate of water and any chemical additives (gallons of each per square foot area).
