

The Ohio EPA has received a request for a modification for the Ohio EPA Permit to Install referenced above.

The Permit to Install issued to Colgate Palmolive Co. (PTI No. 06-1988) is hereby modified in the following manner:

Terms and Conditions on page 3 of Permit to Install issued October 7, 1987.

The reason for the modification is: To correct particulate emission limit on page 3 of PTI No. 06-1988 issued October 7, 1987 due to administrative error.

The above named entity is hereby granted a modification to the permit to install described above pursuant to Chapter 3745-31 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Issuance of this modification does not constitute expressed or implied approval or agreement that, if constructed or modified in accordance with the plans included in the application, the above described source(s) of environmental pollutants will operate in compliance with applicable State and Federal laws and regulations, and does not constitute expressed or implied assurance that if constructed or modified in accordance with those plans included in the application, the above described source(s) of pollutants will be granted the necessary operating permits.
