This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The VOC emissions from this source shall not exceed 2641 lbs/month and 15.85 tons/year. These limits are based on the use of compliance inks and non-compliance inks with incineration and include the emissions from cleanup operations.
The VOC content of the coatings employed shall not exceed 2.9 lbs/gal, minus water and exempt solvents when the incinerator is not being used, and 4.8 lbs VOC/gal solids when the incinerator is being used.

Cleanup material usage in K004 shall not result in the volatilization of more than 30 gal/month of cleaning solvent. The VOC content of the cleanup material employed shall not exceed 6.81 lbs/gal.

When utilizing compliance coatings in K004, the company shall maintain the following monthly records; the name and identification of each coating employed, as applied; the volume of each coating employed, in gallons; the mass of VOC per volume of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied; the amount of VOC emitted from each coating/cleanup material (b x c), in lbs/month; and the total amount of VOC emitted from all coatings/cleanup materials employed
