However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. B. Operational Restrictions

1. The Volatile organic compound (VOC) content of coating employed in this source shall not exceed 5.6 pounds per gallon, excluding water and exempt solvents.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. This facility shall maintain monthly records which list the following information for each material employed in this source:
 - A. the company identification of each coating;
 - B. the VOC content of each coating employed, in pounds per gallon, excluding water and exempt solvents;
 - C. the amount of each coating employed, in gallons;
 - D. the company identification of the liquid organic cleanup material employed;
 - E. the VOC content of the liquid organic cleanup material employed; and
 - F. the amount of liquid organic cleanup material employed, in gallons.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. This Facility shall, on an ongoing basis, evaluate the availability of alternate coatings that will comply with the requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-21-09(U)(1). Should alternate complying coatings become available, this facility shall submit a schedule for implementation of the alternate complying coatings within 30 days of the availability.

This facility shall submit annual reports that summarize the evaluation of alternate coatings which details the following information for each coating evaluated:

- A. the identification of the coating;
- B. the VOC content, in pounds per gallon, excluding water and exempt solvents;
- C. the actual number and types of factory trials conducted;
- D. the reason why the alternative coating does not meet product specifications; and
- E. the cost increase associated with the utilization of the alternate coating.

These reports shall be submitted by February 15 of each year and shall cover the previous calendar year.
