Enclosed please find a modification to the Ohio EPA Permit to Install referenced above which will modify the terms and conditions.



The Permit to Install issued to Ashland Petroleum Company (PTI No. 15-874) is hereby modified in the following manner:


Terms and Conditions on Page 4 of Permit to Install issued September 2, 1992.
