4	<p>NEDO If you update an emission unit under the current facility profile all the updated fields will transfer to the Emission Unit listed under the "Emissions Units" tab on the left hand side of the Facility Profile page.</p> <p>However, the only change that will transfer to the Emission Unit description under the Permit Detail page is the EU ID. The DAPC Description fields (on the permit detail page) will only update if it is blank before syncing the EU's. STARS will not overwrite the DAPC description field and will not update the Company Equipment ID field.</p> <p>If you edit the Emission Unit descriptions under the Permit Detail page, it does not update the data on the other two pages.</p> <p>If you access the individual EU's under the emission unit page, STARS redirects you to the main facility profile page.</p> <p>Eliminating the redundancy of editing emission unit descriptions on two different pages would ease some aggravation and speed the permitting process. Is there a work around to this feature?</p>	Erica Engel-Ishida
