Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection ("Ohio EPA") proposes to amend Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-77. The amendments are being proposed to resolve a Notice of Deficiency(NOD) issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) on April 10, 2002 concerning certain aspects of Ohio's implementation of the Title V Permit program. The Notice of Deficiency is based upon U.S. EPA's finding that Ohio's regulations governing insignificant activities and emissions levels (IEUs) and Ohio's regulations requiring reports of any required monitoring at least every six months, and prompt reports of deviations do not meet the minimum Federal requirements of the Clean Air Act (Act) and 40 CFR part 70. The proposed rule amendments are being submitted to resolve the NOD and avoid the imposition of sanctions established under the Clean Air Act.

Pursuant to Chapter 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule revisions will be conducted on July 28, 2003, at 2:00 p.m., in room 5A at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 122 South Front Street, Columbus, Ohio.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule revisions. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on July 29, 2003, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule review. Written statements submitted after July 29, 2003, may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.
