On June 30, 2004, DHWM proposed a draft revised policy titled: Closure Plan Review Guidance for RCRA Facilities (CPRG). DHWM currently uses the 1999 CPRG, along with years 2000 and 2001 supplements, to convey how Ohio EPA generally expects to exercise its discretion in implementing the hazardous waste closure program. The CPRG is primarily used to assist technical staff with their evaluation of closure plans for hazardous waste management facilities. Facility owners and/or operators may also find it helpful in preparing closure plans for DHWM review.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)-Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for the modification of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit (0PE00000) for the discharge from the existing City of Zanesville Wastewater Treatment Plant. The wastewater treatment plant is located at 1730 Moxahala Avenue, City of Zanesville, Muskingum County, Ohio. Treated wastewaters are proposed to be discharged at the same location. The proposed discharges are to the Muskingum River. Other wastewater disposal alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation or lowering of water quality will be considered by Ohio EPA.

The discharges from this facility, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Muskingum River. The exclusion relates to a combined sewer overflow elimination or reduction project affecting one or more water bodies where there will be a net decrease in the overall pollutant loadings discharged to surface waters of the state.

The Preferred Alternative is the construction of a protected marina by constructing an L-shaped breakwater connected to the shore with docks lining the inside perimeter of the enclosed area with the marina opening on the north side.
