**Notice of Rulemaking**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) has amended the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules that regulate the concentration of radionuclides in public water systems. DDAGW adopted these modifications to achieve consistency between Ohio's rules and USEPA's National Primary Drinking Water Regulations for Radionuclides; Final Rule, as published in the Federal Register December 7, 2000. The State of Ohio is required to adopt these changes in order to maintain primary enforcement responsibility for the drinking water program.

Amendments include the addition of a maximum contaminant level for uranium in drinking water, which was not previously regulated, and best available technologies for the removal of radionuclides in drinking water. Additionally, the amendments add monitoring requirements for uranium and increase the frequency with which affected public water systems are required to monitor for radium-228. Systems without adequate radionuclide historical data will also be required to monitor for gross-alpha particle radioactivity more frequently, at least initially, as a result of these amendments.

DDAGW consolidated the radionuclide maximum contaminant level requirements into one rule, OAC Rule 3745-81-15, and made several revisions to the radionuclide monitoring requirements in OAC Rule 3745-81-26. Due to the extent of the changes, however, DDAGW was required to rescind the existing rules and adopt new rules in their place, resulting in the following rule making actions:

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a project to construct a Wal-Mart Supercenter at 1799-1801 Ohio Pike (State Route 125), Pierce Township, Clermont County, near Amelia, Ohio. The application was submitted by Wal-Mart Stores, Inc., 2001 SE 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Bentonville, Arkansas 72716. As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's preferred alternative would culvert 421 linear feet of an intermittent stream, fill 0.24 acres of forested, Category 1, jurisdictional wetlands, 0.04 acres of non-forested, Category 1, isolated wetlands, and 0.30 acres of forested, Category 2, isolated wetlands. The applicant's minimal degradation alternative would create a buffer strip along the southern edge of the site. It would still culvert 421 linear feet of stream, fill 0.24 acres of Category 2 jurisdictional wetlands, 0.04 acres of Category 1 isolated wetlands, and 0.27 acres of Category 2 isolated wetlands. The applicant's non-degradation would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands. On August 6, 2004, the Louisville District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers issued a Nationwide Permit 39 for this project. The Corps of Engineers project ID number is 200400258-(dmm). The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 042111.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of an unnamed tributary to Lucy Run in the Little Miami River watershed (HUC 05090202). The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.
