**OHIO EPA ISSUES DRAFT CLASS 3
HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT MODIFICATION**

On April 12, 2006, Ohio EPA issued a draft Class 3 hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) modification to Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation (Shieldalloy) for its facility at 60790 Southgate Road, Cambridge, Ohio 43725. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD042319244.

Why is Shieldalloy Modifying its Permit?

Shieldalloy is permitted to store hazardous waste in containers and a containment building. Shieldalloy is requesting a Class 3 modification to reflect the new name and owner of the company, Metallurg Vanadium Corporation, as a result of a corporate restructuring. The draft Permit modification contains the conditions under which the facility must operate if the Permit receives final approval. To issue this draft Permit modification, Ohio EPA determined that the Permit application is complete and meets appropriate standards and that the applicant has a history of compliance with relevant environmental laws, given the potential for harm to the public health and safety and the environment that could result from the irresponsible operation of the facility. When issued, the Permit modification will allow Shieldalloy to continue to investigate and cleanup any contamination of hazardous waste in the designated areas, or constituents that may be at the facility. Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)-Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for the renewal of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the discharge from the Port Clinton Wastewater Treatment Plant phases 1A and 2 Improvements. Public notice is also given that Ohio EPA-DSW has received an application for Permit to Install (PTI) for the construction of the proposed wastewater treatment plant improvements. The NPDES and PTI applications were submitted by the City of Port Clinton, 1868 East Perry Street, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452

The City of Port Clinton preferred wastewater disposal alternative submitted for approval proposes to increase the average daily flow treatment capacity from 1.5 to 2.0 mgd. The disposal system is located at 100 North Jackson Street, Port Clinton, Ottawa County. Treated wastewaters are proposed to be discharged at the same location. The proposed discharges are to the Portage River and Lake Erie.

Other wastewater disposal alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation or lowering of water quality will be considered by Ohio EPA.

The discharges from this facility, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. However, the chemical-specific water quality criteria developed to protect aquatic life and human health, set forth in OAC 3745-1, will not be exceeded. In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality.
