NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 AND ISOLATED WETLANDS APPLICATIONS**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received applications for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification and an isolated wetlands permit for a project involving residential development of approximately 151 acres. Of the developed area, 59 acres will be maintained as green/open space; 57 acres will be developed as single family residential lots; and 18 acres are proposed for residential condominiums. The remaining 17 acres will be developed with streets and rights-of-way. Access to the single family development will be north and south from a single intersection on Slade Road. Access to the condominium development will be off State Route 222 at the south end of the property. The application was submitted by Santoro Engineering Company. The project is located at the intersection of State Route 222 and Slade Road in Batavia Township, Clermont County, Ohio. The Louisville District Corps of Engineers Project Number for this project is 200501752. The Corps has issued a provisional Nationwide Permit #39 for this project. The Ohio EPA ID Numbers for these projects are 062625 and 062690.

The water resources that were verified on the site include 33 non-forested, Category 1 and 2 wetlands totaling 3.78 acres, 3 intermittent streams totaling 5,281 linear feet, 10 ephemeral streams totaling 4,286 linear feet, and 14 ponds totaling 3.48 acres. The project site lies along unnamed tributaries to Back Run and the East Fork Little Miami River, within the Little Miami River watershed (HUC 05090202 120 030).

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 0.65 acres of Category 1 isolated wetlands, 1.31 acres of Category 2 isolated wetlands (total wetland impacts of 1.96 acres), 309 linear feet of ephemeral stream channels, and 311 linear feet of intermittent stream channels (total stream impacts of 620 linear feet). All the stream impacts are due to road crossings. Proposed wetland mitigation would involve the on-site expansion of an existing moderate-quality (Category 2) wetland by 3.9 acres. The proposed stream mitigation is to protect the remaining on-site streams by vegetated buffers and greenspace.

The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact none of the wetlands identified on the property and only 435 lineal feet of stream channels would be impacted by road crossings. The remaining streams would be protected by vegetated buffers and greenspace.

The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of William H. Harsha Lake (formerly East Fork Lake). The proposed development is designed with the intent of controlling the potential for degradation of surface water through engineered control of surface water runoff velocity and the extension of a sanitary sewer from State Route 125. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by 3745-1-05 of the Antidegradation Rule apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

DIRECTOR'S UNILATERAL FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS**

Notice is hereby given that on August 28, 2006, the director of Ohio EPA issued Final Findings and Orders to Mr. Bruce Clark ("Respondent"), whose last known residence is 65 South Chestnut Street, Jackson, Ohio 45640. The Respondent is the owner of a parcel of land that comprises approximately 4 acres that was identified in the records of the Jackson County Recorder's Office as parcel number G11-001-00-005-00. The parcel is located on Caves Road, Jackson, Jackson County, Ohio (the "Property"). These Findings and Orders are issued to resolve violations of the State's solid waste and scrap tire laws and regulations at the Property. The text of the Findings and Orders is set forth below. These Findings and Orders require Respondent to achieve compliance with ORC Chapter 3734 and the rules promulgated thereunder according to the following compliance schedule: 1. On the effective date of the Orders, implement mosquito control measures at the Property and provide copies of mosquito control records to Ohio EPA within ten (10) days after each application of the registered pesticide, larvicide, or adulticide. 2. Not later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of the Orders, establish scrap tire storage piles and fire lanes at the Property. 3. Not later than one hundred twenty (120) days after the effective date of the Orders, remove or cause the removal of all scrap tires from the Property and arrange for their transportation, by a registered scrap tire transporter, to a scrap tire storage, monofill, monocell, or recovery facility or to any other solid waste disposal facility in another state that is operating in accordance with the laws of that state and that is authorized to accept scrap tires for disposal. 4. Obtain receipts from the registered transporter and the authorized scrap tire facility or solid waste disposal facility indicating weight, volume or number of scrap tires transported and forward such documentation to Ohio EPA with seven (7) days after completion of No. 3 above. 5. Continue to comply with Nos. 1 and 2 above until such time as all scrap tires have been removed from the Property. These Final Findings and Orders are subject to all rules, regulations, and specified conditions. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.
