**Ohio Environmental Protection Agency**  
**Proposed amendment of**  
**Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-18-82**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) proposes to amend Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-18-82, Stark county emission limits. The amendments are being proposed to correct the emission limitation for Canton Drop Forge, boiler number one, from 5.0 pounds of sulfur dioxide per MM Btu actual heat input to 2.5 pounds of sulfur dioxide per MM Btu actual heat input. This correction was brought to the attention of Ohio EPA by Canton Drop Forge and is consistent with the most recent attainment demonstration for sulfur dioxide in Stark County.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rule before the division formally adopts them. Due to the administrative nature of this revision, this correction was not released as a draft for interested party review. Ohio EPA will, however, be accepting comments on the proposed rule language. Please see below for details.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on Thursday, October 11, 2007 at 10:00 a.m., in conference room D at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

Pursuant to Part D of Title I of the Clean Air Act, Ohio EPA is required to establish a state implementation plan (SIP) for the attainment and maintenance of the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS). The above mentioned rules are a part of Ohio(s) SIP and the proposed amendments will be submitted to USEPA as a modification of the SIP. The above mentioned hearing shall be considered the public hearing for the SIP submittal.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on October 11, 2007, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. Written statements submitted after October 11, 2007, may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.

Notice of Adoption of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03(E) has adopted new rules 3745-112-01 to 3745-112-08 of the Administrative Code, "Consumer Products."

Rules 3745-112-01 to 3745-112-08 are intended to assist the state of Ohio in achieving and/or maintaining the national 8-hour ground level ozone standard through the regulation of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in consumer products. The rules set standards for the amount of VOCs used in consumer products sold in the state of Ohio. VOC's are a precursor to ozone.

A public hearing on the proposed amendments was held on June 12, 2007 in Columbus, Ohio. After considering comments and oral testimony, the Director's order of adoption was issued on September 5, 2007. The effective date of these rules is September 15, 2007.

This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with ERAC within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action, at 309 South Fourth Street, Suite 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Copies of the appeal must be served upon the Director of the Ohio EPA within three (3) days of filing with ERAC. Ohio EPA also requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Environmental Enforcement Section of the Ohio Attorney General's Office.

**ALTERNATE PARAMETERS LIST REQUEST APPROVAL**

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(2) and OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(3), notice is hereby given that on September 6, 2007, the director of Ohio EPA approves use of an alternate parameter list for BFI, Ottawa County Landfill, 530 North Camp Road, Port Clinton, Ohio 43452. This approval is subject to all rules, regulations, and specified conditions. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Directors action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission.
