Public notice is hereby given that Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft plan approval for the Long Term Combined Sewer Overflow Control Plan for the Village of Hicksville. The plan is for eliminating all combined sewer overflow locations by separating all combined sewers in the wastewater collection system. The estimated cost of the plan is \$12.7 million. Construction of all projects is to be completed within 20 years. The Long-Term Control Plan, which was received by Ohio EPA on September 19, 2008 with revisions received on December 19, 2008, contains an implementation schedule that will be included in the Village's NPDES permit No. 2PB00042, public noticed May 12, 2009.

Ohio EPA will provide an opportunity for public comment concerning this project. Comments received shall be considered by the Director before the plan is issued as final. Any person may submit written comments on the draft plan and administrative record and may request a public hearing. A request for public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues to be raised. In appropriate cases, including cases where there is significant public interest, the director may hold a public hearing on

a draft plan or plans prior to final issuance of the plan or plans. Written comments and/or public hearing requests must be received by the Ohio EPA, Division of Surface Water no later than 30 days from the date of this public notice. Comments and/or public hearing requests should be delivered or mailed to both of the following locations: 1) Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Surface Water, Permits Processing Unit, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, P.O. APPLICATION (LEVEL 2)**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, an Isolated Wetland Permit (Level 2) for a project to construct a middle school and the associated facilities with proposed impacts to 1.21 acres of wetlands. The application was submitted by Avon Local Schools, 35575 Detroit Road, Avon, OH 44011. The project is located on Long Road in Avon. The Ohio EPA Number for this project is 093511.

The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Sections 6111.02 to 6111.028 and other applicable provisions of state laws. Other alternatives as proposed by the applicant resulting in less adverse impact to the isolated wetland ecosystem, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

**OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL COVENANTS TO
FORT RECOVERY INDUSTRIES**

On May 8, 2009, Ohio EPA issued an Environmental Covenant to Fort Recovery Industries, Inc.,(Fort Recovery) for its facility located at 2440 State Route 49, Fort Recovery, Ohio 45846. Fort Recovery is an unpermitted hazardous waste facility and has undergone closure activities. The EPA I.D. number for this facility is OHD005046149.

Fort Recovery must achieve compliance with 5301.80 to 5301.92 of the Ohio Revised Code which restricts the use of its property to limited industrial activities as outlined in the covenants.
