UPPER MAHONING RIVER WATERSHED
TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD REPORT**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) is providing for public review and comment the Upper Mahoning River Watershed Total Maximum Daily Load Report (TMDL) Document. Ohio EPA developed the Document in fulfillment of Section 303(d) of the Clean Water Act, which requires the identification of impaired water bodies for which technology based effluent limitations are not stringent enough to achieve applicable water quality standards and to develop Total Maximum Daily Loads for such waters. The Document addresses impairments in the Mahoning River watershed that appear on the Ohio 2010 303(d) list (assessment units 0503010301 01 through 03, 0503010302 01 through 04, 0503010303 01 through 06, and 0503010304 01 through 06). The impaired waters are located in the Counties of Columbiana, Stark, Mahoning, Portage, Geauga, and Trumbull.

Comments received after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit. After consideration of comments, Ohio EPA will submit the Document to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) for approval.

COVENANT NOT TO SUE/FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS
The Great Lakes Towing Company and Cuyahoga County Great Lakes Towing
Company Property

Notice is hereby given that on June 14, 2011, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Chapter 3746 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Chapter 3745-300, issued a Covenant Not to Sue/Final Findings and Orders to The Great Lakes Towing Company and Cuyahoga County, the Volunteers for property known as Great Lakes Towing Company (the "Property").

The Volunteers conducted a voluntary action of the approximately 2.1897 acre-Property, which is located at 5300 Division Avenue, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio. A no further action letter for the Property was submitted on May 26, 2010 to the Voluntary Action Program of the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental Response and Revitalization, by Eric Wilburn, a Certified Professional as defined in ORC 3746.01(F) and OAC 3745-300-01(A).

This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to ORC 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. ZACLON LLC**

On June 14, 2011, Ohio EPA approved a closure period extension request from Zaclon LLC located at 2981 Independence Rd, Cleveland, Ohio 44115-3699. The EPA I.D. number for this facility is OHD004184768.

Zaclon LLC's May 31, 2011, extension request, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-66-13(B)(2), is due to the significant amount of rain received this spring and the fact that most of the closure activities will occur outdoors. This closure plan period now expires on October 1, 2011. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission.

OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS TO
VEXOR TECHNOLOGY, INC.**

On June 15, 2011, Ohio EPA reached a settlement with Vexor Technology, Inc. (Vexor), for past hazardous waste and surface water violations and issued an administrative consent order. The violations occurred at its facility located at 955 West Smith Road, Medina, Ohio 44256. The consent order includes an exemption from the hazardous waste permitting requirements, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3734.02(G). The exemption allows Vexor to store hazardous waste for up to ten (10) business days provided the requirements found in the exemption are met. The settlement includes \$24,000 in civil penalties.

This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission.
