PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Clemens Development Company have entered into a proposed Consent Order to resolve a Complaint filed against Clemens Development Company on August 3, 2011 in the Greene County Court of Common Pleas, case number 2011-CV-0939. The proposed Consent Order would require Clemens Development Company to immediately comply with the terms and conditions of the 2003 General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activities at the Highveiw Terrace subdivision site. Highview Terrace is a 71 acre development located on the east side of Little Sugarcreek Road, north of State Route 725, Greene County. The proposed Consent Order requires Clemens to submit and comply with an approvable Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan. In addition, the proposed Consent Order requires Clemens Development Corporation to comply with R.C. Chapter 6111 and the rules adopted thereunder, as well as pay a civil penalty of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).
