**Ohio Environmental Protection Agency**  
**Proposed amendment of**  
**Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-25-01 and 3745-25-02**  
**“Ohio’s Ambient Air Quality Standards”**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) proposes to amend Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules 3745-25-01 and 3745-25-02. These rules contain Ohio’s ambient air quality standards (AAQS) and definitions used throughout OAC Chapter 3745-25, “Ambient air quality and emergency episode standards.” The amendments are being proposed to update Ohio’s AAQS and make them equivalent to, but no more stringent than, their federal counterparts.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the Division formally adopts them. On February 3, 2012, these rules went out for a 30-day review by interested parties and were submitted to the Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office for review. No comments were received and the CSI Office made no recommendations regarding these rules.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on Monday, May 7, 2012 at 10:30 AM at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitor's are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

Pursuant to Part D of Title I of the Clean Air Act, Ohio EPA is required to establish a state implementation plan (SIP) for the attainment and maintenance of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The above-mentioned rules are a part of Ohio’s SIP and the proposed amendments will be submitted to USEPA as a modification of the SIP. The above-mentioned hearing shall be considered the public hearing for the SIP submittal.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on Monday, May 7, 2012, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. Written statements submitted after May 7, 2012, may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.

### **PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification to improve water quality within the mainstem of Monday Creek by completing 20 separate remediation projects in four sub-basins of Monday Creek: 17 components in Brush Fork, one in Dixie Hollow, one in Lost Run and one in Snow Fork. Projects include closing mine subsidence and stream captures, constructing stream channels, wetland dikes and water treatment systems including limestone dosers and limestone leach beds. The Monday Creek watershed is approximately 116 square miles and lies within portions of Athens, Hocking and Perry Counties. The application was submitted jointly by Ms. Amy K. Frantz, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District, 502 8th Street, Huntington, WV 25701 and Mr. Mitchell E. Farley, ODNR Division of Mineral Resources Management, 280 East State Street, Athens, Ohio 45701. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113784.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 9,545 linear feet of stream and 2.55 acres of wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 8,918 linear feet of streams and 1.53 acres of wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality within the Monday Creek watershed. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality on 05/08/2012 at 6:00 p.m. at Nelsonville City Hall – City Council Chambers, 211 Lake Hope Drive, Nelsonville, OH 45764. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the application.

Ohio EPA will continue to accept written comments on the application through the close of business on 05/15/2012.
