Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for construction of the ATB-90-13.60 project. The project involves the improvement of the I-90/SR-11 cloverleaf interchange in Plymouth Township, Ashtabula County. The project would eliminate the current restrictive 90 degree turns onto the ramps. Cason Road would be permanently closed under I-90. The existing I-90 bridges over Carson Road would be removed and replaced with roadway embankment. The application was submitted by The Ohio Department of Transportation, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223.

The purpose of the project is to reconfigure the ramps from eastbound I-90 to southbound SR-11 and from northbound SR-11 to eastbound I-90. The proposed work will impact 70 linear feet of Coffee Creek and impact 1.894 acres of four emergent wetlands (0.089 acre impact to Category 1 wetlands and 1.805 acre of impact to Category 2 wetland). This project is within the Grand Watershed (8-digit HUC 04110004). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Project Number is LRH-2008-45-GRA and the Ohio EPA SWIMS ID Number is 124058. The ODOT reference number for this project is ATB-90-13.60 (PID 77256).

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve impacts to a total of 1.894 acres of four wetlands and 0.02 acre (70 linear feet) of Coffee Creek. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact a total of 1.034 acres of four wetlands and 0.02 acre (70 linear feet) of Coffee Creek. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state or U.S., but would not meet the purpose and need for the project.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of 70 linear feet of stream and 1.894 acres of wetland within the Grand Watershed (8-digit HUC 04110004). Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
