Part of Ohio EPA’s Asbestos Emission Control Program

Please note that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control has reviewed Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-20-01, “Definitions and incorporation by reference” and is proposed amended rules to the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR).

The proposed rule language includes two changes to the rule. Ohio EPA is changing the definition of “Facility” in paragraph (C)(18) and removing the definition of “Residential Exempt Structure” in paragraph (C)(45).

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally proposes them. On February 8, 2013, these rules went out for a 40 day review by interested parties.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes will be conducted on **Friday, June 7, 2013 at 10:30 AM** at Ohio EPA Central office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio 43215. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on June 7, 2013 will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. Written statements submitted after June 7, 2013 may be considered as time and circumstances permit, but will not be part of the official record of the hearing.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project that entails the maintenance dredging of authorized Federal navigation channels, and placement of the material in the designated open-lake area. The application was submitted by USACE, Buffalo District, 1776 Niagara Street, Buffalo, NY 14207. The project is located in Huron Harbor and the placement area is located three miles north of the Huron Harbor Light. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is HURON-13. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 134130.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve dredging 350,000 cubic yards of material. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would involve dredging 250,000 cubic yards of material. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Public Notice is hereby given that the Staff of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has recommended to the Director that the Ohio EPA issue a draft action of a Permit to Install (PTI) to BP-Husky Refining, Toledo Refinery (BPH) located in Oregon, Lucas County, Ohio. The draft action (permit number P0111667) was issued on May 2, 2013.

The purpose of the TFO project is to allow BPH to process crude oils originating in the BPH Sunrise fields in Canada, or other crude oils having similar characteristics. The TFO Project will neither increase the refinery's overall crude capacity nor the amount of Canadian or other heavy sour crudes relative to what is currently being processed at the refinery.

The Project will not significantly increase emissions of any conventional pollutant when considered with contemporaneous and creditable increases and decreases at the facility. The Project will, however, trigger Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) pre-construction review for GHGs

For PSD purposes, this project makes BPH a major facility. A PSD analysis was required for any increase in emissions of a pollutant exceeding the PSD threshold emissions level, or the significance levels. Non-Attainment New Source Review was not applicable, due to attainment status.
