Notice of Adoption of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rules in Chapter 3745-113 of the Administrative Code. These rules are related to Architectural and Industrial Maintenance (AIM) Coatings requirements. These rules control emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOC) and are part of Ohio's strategy to control ozone.

Most prominently, Ohio EPA is deleting paragraphs (C) to (E) of OAC rule 3745-113-05. This removes the automatic reporting requirements for coating manufacturers and suppliers. OEPA also made various minor changes to repair typos and bring the rule into line with legislative services commission (LSC) rule formatting guidance.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally adopts them. On April 23, 2013, these rules went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rules was conducted on Monday, September 9, 2013 at Ohio EPA Central Office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio 43215. There were no changes made to the proposed rules and there were no comments received during the public hearing for these rules. The Director's order of adoption was issued on October 8, 2013. **The effective date of these rules is October 18, 2013.**
