Notice is hereby given that on November 8, 2013, the director of Ohio EPA issued a Draft Permit to Install (#834830) to the City of Wilmington, 69 North South Street, Wilmington, Ohio 45177 in Clinton County. The permit, if issued as a final permit, authorizes a vertical expansion of the Wilmington Sanitary Landfill (Facility) located on the west side of South Nelson Avenue, approximately one-half mile south of State Route 22 at 397 South Nelson Avenue, Wilmington, Ohio 45177. The vertical expansion will create an additional 297,261 cubic yards of permitted airspace. The Facility will have a total capacity at 1,945,957 cubic yards on a 21-acre footprint. The anticipated life of the Facility will be 3.3 years based on the Facility's authorized maximum daily waste receipt of 195 tons or 14.5 years based on the Facility's anticipated average daily waste receipt of 59 tons.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code ORC) 3734.05, Ohio EPA will provide an opportunity for public comments concerning this project. Comments received shall be considered by the director before the draft action is issued as final. A public hearing has been scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 17, 2013, at the Wilmington City Council Chambers, 69 North South Street, Wilmington, Ohio 45177 in Clinton County. Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct a series of groins in Lake Erie to stabilize the toe of the slope of the hill at the Perry Township Park to protect the Park infrastructure built atop the hill and to enhance the existing beach sand. The application was submitted by the Perry Township Board of Trustees. The project is located at the Perry Township Park, 2800 Perry Park Road in Perry Township. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in 2,678 cubic yards of fill placed over 29,820 square feet of the bottom of Lake Erie. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
