Notice of Rescission of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has rescinded the rules contained in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-102, "General Conformity."

In April, 2010, USEPA promulgated changes to 40 CFR 51.851 to address SAFETEA-LU. The language in paragraph (a) of 40 CFR 51.851 was changed from "must" to "may", thereby eliminating the need for states to maintain a General Conformity SIP.

Upon completion of a review to fulfill the requirements of ORC 119.032, Ohio EPA determined that our rules were essentially identical to the federal rules in 40 CFR Part 93, Subpart B. Additionally, in the 17 years in which these rules have been in existence, there have been few, if any, projects in the state of Ohio large enough to trigger the requirements in the rules. For these reasons, Ohio EPA determined that maintaining these rules provided no added benefit to the citizens of Ohio. Ohio EPA is, therefore, rescinding the rules in OAC Chapter 3745-102 and will default to the federal requirements in 40 CFR Part 93, Subpart B as necessary.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio EPA was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally adopts them. On February 14, 2014, these rules and the draft business impact analysis document went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. The Director's order of rescission was issued on Monday, June 2, 2014. **The effective date of the rescission is June 12, 2014.**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection has received the following amendment to the Section 208 Plan prepared by the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization: Amendment to the Clean Water Plan for the Village of Peninsula's Wastewater Treatment Prescription in the Cuyahoga Valley Interceptor (CVI) Facilities Planning Area (FPA). Ohio EPA is accepting public comments on this amendment. The public comment period will close at **5:00 p.m. on August 5, 2014.**

Section 208 plans describe and promote efficient and comprehensive programs for controlling water pollution from point and nonpoint sources in a defined geographic area. Area wide Councils of Governments act as the lead planning agencies in 24 Ohio counties; they maintain and update the 208 Plan in their counties. Pursuant to applicable regulations, the State of Ohio has authority to certify that the documents include the required plan elements, are consistent with one another, and are consistent with basin plans. The Governor then certifies the entire 208 Plan via submission to U.S. EPA for their approval.

Ohio EPA Issues Decision Document

On June 4, 2014, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a Decision Document identifying the selected alternative to remediate contamination at the former RCA/Thomson Consumer Electronics site, located at 24200 U.S. Route 23 South, Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio.

The facility manufactured the face plate or panel and funnel components for television picture tubes from 1970 until 2004. The primary contaminants of concern are antimony, arsenic and lead. The selected remedial alternative in the Decision Document includes: 1) removal of contaminated soil and sediment from the East Swale, South Ditch, Former Raw Material Handling Area, and Off-site Creek Area to acceptable concentrations, including transportation of excavated material to off-site disposal facilities, restoration of removal areas to pre-construction grades, and vegetating of disturbed areas; 2) rehabilitation of the East Fenced Area, including clearing/grubbing of existing vegetation, placement of a one-foot thick soil cover, repair/replacement/expansion of the existing security fencing, and ongoing maintenance of the soil cover, vegetation and fence; and 3) adherence to the institutional controls included in environmental covenants established for the former facility property and Off-site Creek Area property.

On February 25, 2014, Ohio EPA issued a Preferred Plan that outlined Ohio EPA's preferred alternative to remediate contamination at the site. A public meeting was held April 9, 2014, during which public comments on the Preferred Plan were accepted. In addition, written comments on the Preferred Plan were accepted through April 18, 2014. No comments on the Preferred Plan were received by Ohio EPA during the comment period.

The effective date of this final action is June 4, 2014. You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based.
