Proposed Rulemaking Governing
Construction and Demolition Debris Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 3714.02 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 106 of the Ohio Revised Code, proposes to amend the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

3745-400-03	Facility exclusions.
3745-400-04	Authorized, limited, and prohibited construction and demolition debris disposal methods.
3745-400-05	Clean hard fill.
3745-400-07	Facility design requirements and construction specifications.
3745-400-08	Construction and final closure certification.
3745-400-09	Site characterization.
3745-400-12	Final closure of facilities.

These rules address regulations for construction and demolition debris (C&DD) facilities.

The purpose of this rule making is to satisfy the five year rule review requirements under Section 106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The public comment period will run until February 5, 2015. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held on February 5, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rulemaking.
