Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft of a new general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit that may potentially provide coverage to small sanitary discharge systems in the state of Ohio. This draft permit represents a renewal of the small sanitary permit issued in 2010.

This new permit covers existing sanitary treatment discharges that are not currently meeting Best Available Demonstrated Control Technology (BADCT) treatment standards. The permit includes a compliance schedule requiring operators to upgrade their treatment systems to meet BADCT standards within 18 months of obtaining coverage under the permit.

The BADCT standards apply to the following parameters: Dissolved Oxygen, Carbonaceous Biochemical Oxygen Demand, Total Suspended Solids, Ammonia, *Escherichia coli*, Fecal Coliform, and Residual Chlorine.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) maintenance dredging project located in Fairport Harbor. The application was submitted by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District. The project is located within the limits of the Federal navigation channel of Fairport Harbor, which is located on the southern shore of Lake Erie at the mouth of the Grand River (a major tributary to Lake Erie), and within the Grand River. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is Fairport -15. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144586.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would dredge an estimated 400,000 cubic yards of sediment from the harbor with placement of the dredged material at the existing open-lake and near shore areas in Lake Erie. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would dredge an estimated 250,000 cubic yards of sediment from the harbor, with placement of the dredged material at the existing open-lake and near shore areas in Lake Erie. The proposed project is scheduled to occur between June 15 and September 15 in an effort to minimize impacts to local environmental resources, primarily fisheries. Dredging will not occur during Lake Erie storm events. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie and the Grand River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
