Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 3734.02 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 106, proposes to amend the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

- 3745-30-02 Applicability.
- 3745-30-03 Residual waste characterization.
- 3745-30-04 Residual waste landfill classification.
- 3745-30-05 Residual waste landfill facility permit to install application.
- 3745-30-06 Additional criteria for approval of residual solid waste landfill facility permit to install applications.
- 3745-30-07 Residual waste landfill facility construction.
- 3745-30-08 Ground water monitoring program.
- 3745-30-09 Final closure of residual waste landfill facilities.
- 3745-30-10 Post closure care of residual waste landfill facilities.
- 3745-30-14 Operation of residual waste landfill facilities.

These rules address residual solid waste landfill regulations.

The purpose of this rule making is to correct inaccurate references contained in the residual waste rules. These references point to sections of rules in the Ohio Administrative Code that are not correct or no longer exist. The appendices have also been corrected to mirror the Legislative Service Commission's style requirements for naming appendices.

The public comment period will run until March 3, 2015. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held on March 3, 2015 at 10:30 at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rulemaking.

Written comments may also be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-114-01 contains a list of compounds which, when emitted by a facility, may be cause for the director of Ohio EPA to require a permit-to-install under OAC chapter 3745-31. Pursuant to a court decision by the 10<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals and the requirements of ORC 119.032, Ohio EPA completed a review of OAC rule 3745-114-01 and found the need to add compounds to the list of toxic air contaminants contained in the rule.

On August 18, 2014, these rules and the draft business impact analysis document went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Evergreen Environmental Corp., (Defendant Evergreen) have entered into a proposed Consent Order to resolve those counts of the Complaint filed in Trumbull County Court of Common Pleas, case number 2013 CV 00674, that pertain to Defendant Evergreen.
