- 3745-27-62 Criteria for approval of application for a registration certificate or for a permit to install for a scrap tire facility. Amend**

Laboratory Certification**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) drafted revisions to Rule 3745-81-27 and the laboratory certification rules found in Chapter 3745-89 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The proposed amendments are a result of the five year rule requirements set forth in Section 106.03 of the Revised Code.

Revisions to these rules include the include the addition, removal and clarification of the definitions; addition of exceptions to lab certification requirements; incorporation of Ohio EPA lab manuals (microbiological and chemical) as rules by reference; addition of detailed renewal fee information; addition of requirements for annual review of quality assurance plan; inclusion of MMO-MUG (SM 9223) tests and interim authorization for this testing; addition of situations when the director may deny, suspend or revoke a laboratory certification; addition of requirements for out of state laboratories; addition of requirements for documentation; and, simplification of proficiency testing requirements. Proposed revisions to Rule 3745-81-27 include the addition of specifics for approved analytical methods for microbiological analyses to provide emphasis as well as prepare for the upcoming revised total coliform rule changes. Rule 3745-89-11 is being rescinded and replaced as new due to the amount of changes in information for certified laboratories that do testing for the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule.

A public hearing pursuant to §106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code will be conducted on March 17, 2015, beginning at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room B at the Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Columbus, Ohio. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give their written or oral comments on this proposed rulemaking. A presiding officer will be present until all interested persons have been heard.

Public Notice: Final Rulemaking on Primary Drinking Water
Standards and Plan Approval Rule Amendments**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) adopted revisions to rule 3745-91-03 and Chapter 3745-81 in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) establishing plan approval and primary drinking water standards for the state of Ohio. These rules have been reviewed pursuant to the five year rule review requirements of Section 106.03 of the Revised Code.

Revisions to these rules are mostly minor. OAC rules 3745-81-22 and 3745-81-78 are proposed to be rescinded because the Stage 1 Disinfectant and Disinfection Byproduct (D/DBP) requirements have been replaced with Stage 2 D/DBP requirements, which are contained in other rules. Revisions to rules 3745-81-15 and 3745-81-24 include updating a reference and removing outdated language. Draft amendments to rules 3745-81-26, 3745-81-33, 3745-81-81, 3745-81-87 and 3745-91-03 will clarify requirements.

The Director of Environmental Protection, after considering public comment, adopted these rules in final form, pursuant to Section 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Director's order of adoption was issued on February 13, 2015. The effective date of the amended rules will be February 23, 2015 in accordance with Section 119.04(A) of the Revised Code.

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 3734.52 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 106, proposes to amend the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

3745-502-01 Solid waste fee - definitions.

3745-502-02 Requirements for collecting, remitting, and reporting state disposal and environmental protection fees.

These rules address regulations and definitions regarding the collection and remitting of fees assessed on the disposal of solid waste in Ohio.

The purpose of this rule making is to fulfill the five year rule review requirements under section 106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. Revisions were also made to correct inaccurate dates in the rules and clarify that Chapter 3745-502 of the Ohio Administrative Code is not applicable to construction and demolition debris facilities.

The public comment period will run until March 16, 2015. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 106.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held on March 16, 2015 at 10:30 at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to reroute an existing stream channel to Lake Erie. The purpose of this new stream channel is to contain water flow resulting from a probable maximum flood event, routing the water away from the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. In addition to the created stream channel, several other features are required to complete the project. This includes grading along the east and west banks of the proposed stream to meet existing grade or to create a small berm, a fill area to the southwest of the existing stream channel, straightening a section of the concrete vehicle barrier system and a new outlet structure to Lake Erie. The application was submitted by FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company. The project is located at 10 Center Road, east of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant in North Perry. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2014-00108. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144414.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in the filling of 1.459 acres of non-forested Category 1 wetlands, 0.55 acres of forested Category 2 wetlands, 0.082 acres of non-forested Category 2 wetlands and 3.55 acres of Category 3 forested wetlands. Stream impacts will result from filling 3,004 linear feet of intermittent stream and 206 linear feet of ephemeral feet. Impacts to Lake Erie are the same for both alternatives, with the placement of 885 cubic yards of material along 125 linear feet of shoreline 34 feet into the Lake. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in the filling of 1.776 acres of non-forested Category 1 wetlands, 0.50 acres of forested Category 2 wetlands, 0.082 acres of non-forested Category 2 wetlands and 2.95 acres of Category 3 forested wetlands. Stream impacts will result from filling 3,037 linear feet of intermittent stream and 206 linear feet of ephemeral feet. Impacts to Lake Erie are the same for both alternatives, with the placement of 885 cubic yards of material along 125 linear feet of shoreline 34 feet into the Lake. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality.

All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
