Notice is hereby given that on March 3, 2015, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Chapter 3746 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Chapter 3745-300, issued a Covenant Not To Sue/Final Findings and Orders to the City of Lancaster and Lancaster Port Authority the "Volunteers" for property known as the Former Frick-Gallagher property (the "Property").

The Volunteers conducted a voluntary action of the approximately 5 acre-Property, which is located at 330 South Ewing Street, Fairfield County, Ohio. A no further action letter for the Property was submitted on July 21, 2014 to the Voluntary Action Program of the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental Response and Revitalization by Steven M. Gross, a Certified Professional as defined in ORC 3746.01(F) and OAC 3745-300-01(A).

This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to ORC 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio", which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. Ohio EPA and FWS Issue Draft Restoration Plan and Environmental Assessment for the Nease Chemical Facility, Salem, Ohio; Community Meeting to be held

On March 5, 2015 the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and United States Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) (jointly the Trustees) issued a Draft Restoration Plan and Environmental Assessment (RP/EA) concerning the Nease Chemical site located at State Route 14A, Salem, Columbiana County, Ohio (Site). The RP/EA has been prepared by the Trustees to address natural resources injured and ecological services lost due to releases of hazardous substances from the former Nease facility.

The Trustees are in settlement negotiations with the Potentially Responsible Party (PRP) in which the PRP would implement various projects to compensate the public for injuries to natural resources due to releases of hazardous substances from the former Nease Chemical facility. Therefore, the purpose of this RP/EA is to present the Trustees' Preferred Alternative to accomplish the goal of restoring, rehabilitating, replacing and/or acquiring the equivalent of those natural resources injured, and the services those resources provide. Public comments are being sought on this RP/EA and will be considered and incorporated in the Final RP/EA as appropriate.

The Trustees will hold a community meeting on April 9, 2015, to answer questions and to accept comments on the Preferred Plan. The community meeting will begin at 6 pm at the Salem Public Library (Quaker Room) located at 821 E. State Street, Salem, Ohio 44460. The community meeting will begin with an information session during which the Trustees will present a summary of the RP/EA and answer questions. After the information session the public can submit oral or written comments for the record regarding the RP/EA.

In addition, the Trustees will accept written comments through April 17, 2015. Anyone may submit written comments on the RP/EA by writing to: Sheila Abraham, Site coordinator, Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office, 2110 East Aurora Road, Twinsburg, Ohio 44087. The Trustees will consider all comments submitted during the public comment period before taking a final action.

PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Roman Kremer, et al., (Defendants) have entered into a proposed Consent Order to resolve the Complaint filed on April 12, 2013 in the Darke County Court of Common Pleas, Case Number 13CV000222 against the Defendants for violations of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111, specifically those provisions related to violating their PTI by failing to comply with freeboard requirements, violating their LAMP permit, and discharging pollution to waters of the state without a permit. The proposed Consent Order requires injunctive relief be completed but Defendants transferred ownership of the lagoon at Wabash Farm which is relieving them of those requirements. In addition, the proposed Consent Order requires the Defendants to pay a civil penalty.
